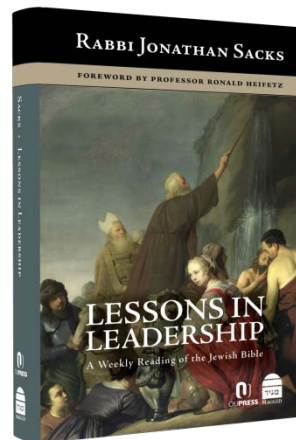

LESSONS IN LEADERSHIP: A Weekly Reading of the Jewish Bible

Rabbi Sacks finds that “the Bible itself is a product of a people who, more than three thousand years ago, struggled to generate better forms of social organization” — and those same struggles continue today. Today, people seem to mistake leadership for those with sure-fire answers, rather than seek out a source who will challenge. Sacks insists that leadership isn’t necessarily born but taught, and must be learned so that each of us will take responsibility for shared issues.
